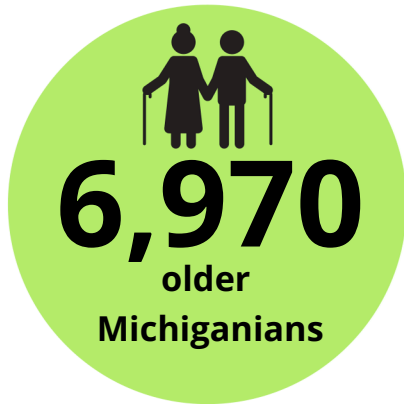

As of FY 2024,



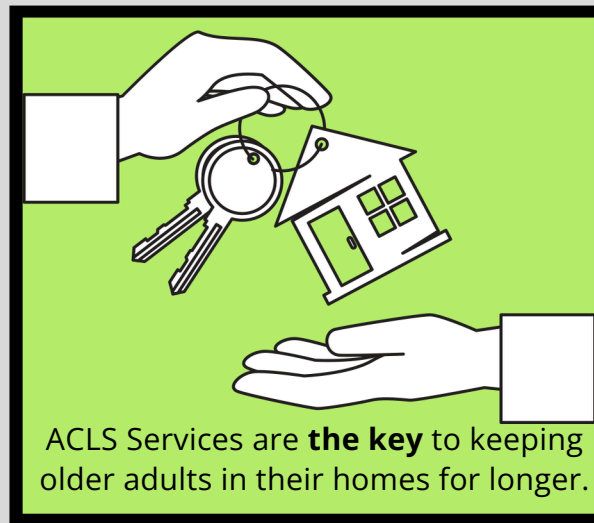
are on waiting lists for in-home care and home-delivered meals.

Additional funding supports program growth in response to rising demand, aids the direct care workforce, and addresses the rising costs of providing services.



If ACLS Services can keep only 96 older adults out of Medicaid-funded nursing homes for 1 year, the increase will have paid for itself.

The Silver Key Coalition is requesting a permanent increase of \$8 million for In-Home Services and \$2 million for Home Delivered Meals in the Bureau of Aging, Community Living, and Supports (ACLS Bureau) FY 2026 Budget.
